This Code of Ethics is endorsed by all Directors and Affiliates.

1. The FSAB strives to be fair and objective in all of its actions and does not discriminate with regard to ascribed or achieved status.
2. Directors and Affiliates shall exercise professional and personal conduct consistent with the best interests and objectives of the FSAB.
3. No Director or Affiliate shall materially misrepresent his or her credentials, training, experience or status within the FSAB.
4. No Director or Affiliate shall materially misrepresent the undertakings of the FSAB.
5. No Director or Affiliate shall issue a public statement(s) on behalf of the FSAB without first obtaining specific authority from the Executive Committee.
6. Directors and Affiliates shall sign annually and abide by the FSAB confidentiality agreement.
7. Non conformity of any Director or Affiliate to this Code shall be considered the basis for removal from the Board following the complaint process of the Policy and Procedures Manual.
